(For premises that are not a conveyance)
Sections 22 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

PURSUANT to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, C&C (2023) Limited is authorised to sell and supply alcohol, on the premises situated at 41 Bow Street RAGLAN and known as Raglan Town Hall, to any person attending the following event:

Raglan Harmony Wine Festival - 8/2/25

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

CONDITIONS

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- a) Alcohol may be sold under the licence only on the following days and during the following hours:
Saturday, 8 February 2025 from 1.00pm to 5.00 pm
- b) A reasonable range of food shall be available within the market area during the hours of this licence.
- c) The licensee shall have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when alcohol may be sold and supplied under the licence, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic refreshments and low alcoholic beverages.
- d) Drinking water is to be freely available to attendees at the bar service area.
- e) The following steps must be taken to ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed:
 - i. Ensure that no intoxicated persons are allowed to enter or to remain on the premises.
 - ii. Ensure that appropriate signs are prominently displayed detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of liquor to minors and intoxicated persons adjacent to every point of sale.
 - iii. Ensure that appropriate signs are prominently displayed detailing information about alternative forms of transport from the premises including provision of a courtesy vehicle to transport patrons from the premises.
- f) A certificate holding manager is required to be on site and on duty to manage the conduct of the sale and supply of alcohol during the hours of this licence.
- g) The whole of the premises is designated as SUPERVISED.

DISPLAY OF LICENCE

The licensee must ensure a copy of the licence and the conditions subject to which it is issued is displayed inside the premises so as to be easily read by people using the premises.

DURATION

This licence is in force from 1.00pm to 5.00pm 08 February 2025.
